Annexure: Anti-Ragging Undertaking - Important Notice for Students

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has revised the procedure for students to file an Anti-Ragging Undertaking. This revision signifies a move towards a completely digitized system, aiming to streamline the process and enhance accessibility.

Key Changes

1. Online Undertaking: Students are no longer required to submit any hard/printed affidavit related to Anti-Ragging to the institute.
2. Centralized Portal: The mandatory Anti-Ragging Undertaking must be completed online by all students on the official website: (<http://www.antiragging.in/>).

Students can access the portal from anywhere with an internet connection and complete the undertaking at their own pace.

Upon accessing (<http://www.antiragging.in/>), students will encounter a user-friendly interface guiding them through the online undertaking process. This process may involve:

- * Registering with basic information (name, registration number, etc.)
- * Reading and understanding the detailed description of ragging and its consequences.
- * Answering questions related to anti-ragging awareness and commitment.
- * Submitting the online undertaking electronically.

The online Anti-Ragging Undertaking system embodies a progressive approach towards fostering a safe and inclusive learning environment. We remain committed to upholding a zero-tolerance policy against ragging and encourage all students to actively participate in creating a culture of mutual respect and dignity within our institution.
